

Housing information

Accommodations at Geneva Point Center are modest and considered “rustic.” All Tier One, Two, and Three housing has electricity, and most have private bathrooms. Bedding, pillows and towels—including a midweek towel exchange—are included in Tier One, Two, and Three housing. In housing with bunk beds, no camper is assigned to sleep in an upper bunk unless they volunteer to do so. We will advise you of your housing assignment and roommates or cabinmates before the start of camp. Photos and additional information can be found on our website at nordicfiddlesandfeet.org/housing.

Tier One

- **Gibbes House:** 4 first-floor rooms and 6 second-floor rooms, each with a private full bathroom; assorted bed configurations; kitchen, large central living room that hosts the nyckelharpa classes.
- **Lake View Cabins:** 4 duplex cabins, each unit having a private full bathroom. 1 unit has three twin beds; 4 have a queen bed; 3 have a queen bed and a trundle twin bed.
- **Lake View Lodge:** 4 first-floor rooms and 6 second-floor rooms, each having two double beds and a private full bathroom; a common room that NFF may use for classes, kitchen and porch with lake views.

Tier Two

- **Chapel Line:** 4 duplex cabins, each unit having a private full bathroom. 7 units have two twin beds and a bunk bed; 1 unit has a queen bed and a bunk bed.
- **Cottage F:** triplex cabin, each unit having two twin beds and a private full bathroom.
- **College Row:** 6 cabins with a private full bathroom; each having a king bed and a bunk bed. The king beds can be configured as 2 twin beds upon request.
- **State Line:** 4 cabins with a queen bed and a bunk bed and private half bathroom. Each cabin has a private shower in a shared State Line shower house.
- **Tree Cabins:** 2 duplex cabins, each unit having a king bed, a bunk bed, and a private full bathroom. The king beds can be configured as 2 twin beds upon request.

Tier Three

- **Inn:** 14 second-floor rooms: 3 with double beds, 11 with two twin beds, shared men’s and women’s bathrooms are down the hall. A limited number of single-occupancy rooms are available.
- **Malden:** 4 second-floor rooms that share a full bathroom. 3 have two twin beds, 1 has a double bed.
- **Dock Road:** 8 rustic cabins with 4 lower bunks and 3 upper bunks and a private half bathroom; showers in the Shower House. An upper bunk is assigned only upon camper request.

Tier Four comprises 6 RV/tent spots, with water and electric hookups. Only one RV or tent allowed per spot.

Occupancy: Campers registering at the adult, young adult, or companion adult rate need to indicate their preferred occupancy, which determines their registration rate and reflects the number of adult, young adult, or companion adult campers sharing a room or cabin. Occupancy rates do not include any campers age 17 or younger.

Full-time and part-time options: We understand that campers may be unable to attend the full week of camp for any number of reasons. We have priced our part-time rates to accommodate these campers fairly. However, preference will be given to full-time campers when we assign housing. We will do our best to place part-time campers in their preferred tier, but they may need to be accommodating with regard to occupancy.
